**Pump-up or Power Sprayer:** Mix 4 oz (118 ml) of Green-Line Prespray into 1 gallon (3.78 L) of warm to hot water. (1:32 dilution)

## **Hydro-Force Sprayer:**


**4:1 no tip:** Mix 20 oz (590 ml) of Green-Line Prespray into Hydro-Force jug and fill with warm to hot water.

**9:1 yellow tip:** Mix 40 oz (1:18 L) of Green-Line Prespray into Hydro-Force jug and fill with warm to hot water.

Pile lift or vacuum prior to cleaning. Spray diluted Green-Line Prespray onto carpet at the rate of 800 - 1000 square feet per gallon. Allow 15 minutes dwell time, then rinse with hot water extraction. For best results vacuum after carpet is dry.
